



PART-TIME GARDENER POSITION AVAILABLE BEGINNING IMMEDIATELY

The John P. Humes Japanese Stroll Garden is a four-acre gem of landscape design on the northern shore of Long Island in Mill Neck, New York. The garden is looking for a part-time gardener to help with a busy 2010 season.

Responsibilities include: garden maintenance (i.e. watering, weeding, planting, grooming, and building maintenance); assisting with tour and exhibit preparations; working with the garden's director and full-time gardener, and volunteers; and interacting with garden members and the public.

Position starts in early spring and ends in late fall. A commitment of 24 hours per week is required including Friday and alternate weekends during the garden's open season. Private tours are conducted on Thursday and Friday. Public tours on designated Saturdays start at 10:00 a.m. Open to the public Saturday and Sunday, 11:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., from April 24 through October 24, 2010.

Qualified applicants will demonstrate a commitment to the field of horticulture. The garden is a labor intensive work environment only applicants who are prepared for this unique experience should apply.
